The purpose of this meeting is for family members to meet with Departmental representatives and discuss issues concerning the incarceration of their loved one(s). Offenders are responsible for notifying anyone on their **APPROVED VISITATION LIST** who may want to register online for this meeting.

Registration Ends: April 16, 2026 at midnight

Capacity: Limited to 275 registrants; registration portal will close once capacity reaches 275

### HOW TO REGISTER TO ATTEND FAMILY DAY

- Click the "Friends & Family" tab
- Click "Registration" located in the Family Day box
- When a new window opens, follow the prompts to register for Family Day

### WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

#### How should you prepare for Family Day?

- Prior to arriving, consider what questions you might have and write them down.

#### What should you expect when you arrive?

- Check-in at Roberts Chapel; please have your ID and the offender's GDC number readily available
- GDC will have security procedures in place to ensure fast processing, please only bring what is necessary (i.e. pen, paper, ID, keys)
- Family or significant others must be on the **offender's approved visitation list and registered for the meeting**
- GDC will issue color-coded numbers, corresponding to the individual/section with whom you wish to speak
- Attendees must remain in the auditorium until number is called
- Once your number is called, groups of 15-20 will be ushered to the appropriate area.

#### Physical Assistance

- If you require physical assistance, please inform a GDC representative during check-in.

#### Recommended Attire

- We recommend wearing comfortable clothing and shoes. There is a possibility you will be walking or standing for extended periods of time.

#### Time with GDC Representative

- In order to ensure we are able to address the concerns of as many individuals as possible, please try to limit your time spent with a GDC representative to 10 minutes.  
For those who would like to speak with the Commissioner, scheduling will be based on first-come, first-serve. The Commissioner will see a total of 18 people, with each meeting lasting no more than 10 minutes.
