Health & risk assessment, reentry planning.

What Contact is Permitted?

Phone and/or in-person visits per facility rules.

None. Outgoing emergency contact only

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Phone, video or in-person visits

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VISITOR TIPS

No tank-tops, nothing mesh or see-through, t-shirts cannot be sleeveless



No chest, shoulders or stomach exposed. No tank-tops, sleeveless or see-through items

Full length pants only. Only children may wear shorts

Shorts no more than 2" above the knee, no stretch pants or shorts
